Enos Mills spent his life discovering and experiencing nature, sharing its benefits with others through nature guiding and his writing and photographs, and working tirelessly to preserve it. Like Enos Mills, the award recipient has demonstrated leadership and commitment to the field of EE through a body of work.

For a person to be considered for the Enos Mills Lifetime Achievement Award, he/she must be nominated by his/her peers.

3. Provide examples that demonstrate leadership. Specifically address how the nominee inspires peers, shows dedication, emulates professional life in personal life, demonstrates perseverance in the face of adversity, and/or formed community partnerships.

C. Supplemental Materials (4-page limit)

You may integrate other material and information into the nomination that will assist the awards committee in getting to know this person (e.g., samples of program/participants' evaluations, program brochures, photos, letters of support).

D. Submit Nomination
